

SPRING/SUMMER SESSION ASSISTANCE

For students who receive post secondary educational assistance, the first priority for budget expenditures remains full time, fall/winter studies. Students who wish to receive financial support for spring/summer session studies must; therefore, provide documentation which demonstrates why these courses should be taken during these sessions.

In order to be considered for funding a student must:

- have completed **one (1)** full academic year of studies at university
 - be carrying a course load of **four (4)** or more full credits
 - have received a mid-term mark of at least **C** on each course.
1. Students should apply for funding at the beginning of April for these sessions. Applications forms are available upon request.
 2. All applications for spring/summer sessions must be accompanied by an education plan which lists not only the courses to be taken during spring/summer break but also those to be taken, by session and year, to complete the program requirements.
 3. Financial assistance will be as follows:
 - i. tuition and books/supplies for ½ credit courses and
 - ii. tuition, books/supplies and living allowance for full credit courses.
 4. **Approval will be dependent upon availability of funds.**
