Subject: **Residency Review Hearings**

The Acadia First Nation has a Residency Bylaw, which can be found on the AFN website. One of the purposes of the Residency Bylaw is to foster and maintain safe, healthy, peaceful and respectful communities.

Under the Residency Bylaw, complaints about Reserve Residents can be filed with Chief and Council. Some complaints are resolved through informal processes. In some situations, including in the event of an emergency, Chief and Council can make a decision without holding a Hearing. In other cases, Chief and Council can ask a Band member to attend a Residency Review Hearing.

Chief and Council can ban an AFN member from the reserves for reasons which include:

1. 7.1(b) – if a member is reasonably perceived to be a danger to the welfare of other residents;
2. 7.1(d) – if a member is reasonably believed to be interfering with the ability of other residents to live safely, in a healthy manner and in peace.

Residency Review hearings are open to Reserve Residents to attend. The decision from the Hearing is provided to Band members by this Notice.

As a result of complaints received, Residency Review Hearings were held on October 6, 2022. Chief and Council has decided:

1. **Justin Bollivar** – a two year ban from all AFN reserves, with a right to apply to Chief and Council for a suspension (lifting) of that ban after 6 months by presenting a satisfactory detailed rehabilitation plan.
2. **Danny Johnson** - a two year ban from all AFN reserves, with a right to apply to Chief and Council for a suspension (lifting) of that ban after 6 months by presenting a satisfactory detailed rehabilitation plan.
