Subject: **Residency Review Hearing**


The Acadia First Nation has a Residency Bylaw, which can be found on the AFN website. One of the purposes of the Residency Bylaw is to foster and maintain safe, healthy, peaceful and respectful communities.

Under the Residency Bylaw, complaints about Reserve Residents can be filed with Chief and Council. Some complaints are resolved through informal processes. In some situations, including in the event of an emergency, Chief and Council can make a decision without holding a Hearing. In other cases, Chief and Council can ask a Band member to attend a Residency Review Hearing.

Under the Bylaw, Chief and Council can, for cause, ban an AFN member from the reserves or revoke the allocation of a home on reserve.

Residency Review hearings are open to Reserve Residents to attend. The decision from the Hearing is provided to Band members by this Notice.

As a result of complaints received involving Darcy Johnson, a Residency Review Hearing was held on October 6, 2022. Chief and Council has decided to offer Darcy Johnson a two year probationary Occupancy Agreement for his current residence at 6 Gloade Lane, Gold River Reserve.
