

Our Head Start program runs from Monday to Thursday and has 7 children currently enrolled. We are very proud of our Head Start program and have had great successes over the past 10 years. Our Head Start program is based on six components which are as follows: culture and language, education, health promotion, nutrition, social support and parental involvement. We have been very fortunate to have the support of our Chief and Council along with Health Canada, North Shore Development, INAC, MK, METS and community organizations to assist in our program and professional development.

Our after School Program consisted of anywhere between 10-18 children, ages 5-12. This runs daily from 2pm-5pm where we provided daily snacks, activities, and homework hours for the children.

Our drop in program ran from 5pm-9pm Monday thru Saturday in which children and youth between the ages of 5-16. Our center is available to them as a support network, a social place and a fun, safe and secure facility for our youth to gather.

Our Day Camp program ran over March Break with approx 20 children between the ages of 5-12, with many daily themed activities, games, sports, and crafts related to the themes. Some of our outside activities included a trip to Empire Theatres and swimming at the Rodd Grand Hotel.

Our Summer Day Camp program consisted of 20-25 children between the ages of 5-12 and included weekly themes such as messy week, water week, Outdoor adventures, Olympics, to name a few. Some of our trips included Atlantic Play land, and various local day trips to beaches and parks. This was very successful this summer and a lot of fun for our children and youth.

Our Youth Center has been in operation for over 10 years and has had much success in our programs.
